## Imperial Cities of Morocco Adventure (6 days)

Embark on an exhilarating 6-day motorbike adventure through the captivating landscapes and Imperial north Cities of Morocco, starting and finishing in Albox. This unique journey takes you from the arid plains of Andalusia, crossing the Mediterranean on an overnight ferry from Almería to Nador, to explore the historic Imperial City of Fes and the vibrant Blue City of Chefchaouen. Return via the Spanish enclave of Ceuta and Algeciras, riding thrilling winding mountain roads back to Albox, creating unforgettable memories from two continents.

### Detailed Itinerary

- 1 Day 1: Albox – Port of Almería – Overnight Ferry to Nador (180 km + ferry)**

Departure from Albox towards the port of Almería via picturesque mountain roads Calar Alto with more than 2000 m altitud. We will traverse the arid landscapes of eastern Andalusia, passing through the Tabernas desert region. Arrival at Almería port in the afternoon with time to prepare the motorbikes and complete ferry documentation. In the evening, we will board the overnight ferry to Nador with accommodation in comfortable cabins. This crossing offers a unique experience as we sail across the Mediterranean towards the African continent.
- 2 Day 2: Nador – Fes (310 km)**

After disembarking in Nador in the morning, we will complete customs and entry formalities for Morocco. We will enjoy a traditional Moroccan breakfast before beginning our journey south through the Rif Mountains towards Fes. The route takes us through changing landscapes from the Mediterranean coast to mountain passes and, finally, to the plains approaching Fes. Arrival in the afternoon at the Imperial City of Fes, one of Morocco's most fascinating cities. Accommodation in a comfortable hotel near the Medina where you will experience authentic Moroccan hospitality. Free evening to explore the ancient streets and enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.
- 3 Day 3: Fes – Chefchaouen (200 km)**

Morning departure from Fes after exploring the famous Medina and its souks. We will ride northwest through the heart of the Rif Mountains on winding roads with spectacular views. The landscape becomes increasingly green as we ascend into the mountains. The route offers challenging curves and breathtaking panoramas. Arrival in Chefchaouen, the famous blue city nestled in the mountains. Accommodation in a charming hotel. Free afternoon and evening to wander through the photogenic blue-washed streets, visit local artisan shops, and enjoy the relaxed mountain atmosphere.
- 4 Day 4: Chefchaouen – Tarifa (approximately 165 km)**

After a leisurely morning exploring Chefchaouen's iconic blue streets and enjoying breakfast with mountain views, we depart towards Tarifa. The route takes us through the northern Rif Mountains with spectacular views of both the Mediterranean and Atlantic coasts. We'll pass through Berber villages and enjoy the final stretches of Moroccan mountain roads before reaching the port for the ferry crossing to Tarifa. Once in Tarifa, we'll experience the unique atmosphere of Spain's southernmost point, where the Mediterranean meets the Atlantic. Accommodation at Hotel Los Lances with dinner and rest before tomorrow's journey to Albox.
- 5 Day 5: Tarifa – Granada (approximately 230 km)**

Departure from Tarifa heading northeast through the stunning white villages of Andalusia. We'll ride through the Sierra de Cádiz and Sierra de Málaga on spectacular winding mountain roads, passing through picturesque pueblos blancos like Ronda. The route offers challenging curves, breathtaking views, and authentic Andalusian culture. Arrival in Granada in the late afternoon with time to explore the historic city. Accommodation in a comfortable hotel with optional evening visit to see the illuminated Alhambra.
- 6 Day 6: Granada – Albox (approximately 240 km)**

Final day of our cross-continental adventure. Departure from Granada heading through the dramatic and stunning desert eastern Andalusia. We'll ride through mountain passes and valleys, enjoying technical curves and stunning desert scenery as we approach Almería province. The route takes us through varied terrain from green mountain areas to the arid beauty of the Tabernas region. If time allows, we'll include some beautiful dirt tracks on specially selected routes. Arrival in Albox in the late afternoon, completing our unforgettable journey through Morocco and Andalusia with memories to last a lifetime.

### Frequently Asked Questions

- ▼ Do I need a special licence to ride in Morocco?

You need a valid motorbike licence from your country. International Driving Permits are recommended but not compulsory. Our guides will assist you with any paperwork at border crossings.
- ▼ What type of motorbike is best for this tour?

Our fleet includes KTM Adventure 890/390 R and CFMoto 450 motorbikes, carefully selected to suit all rider skill levels. These adventure bikes are ideal for this route with excellent ground clearance for off-road sections. If you choose the 100% asphalt option, any touring motorbike will be suitable. You can ride your own motorbike or hire one from our fleet.
- ▼ Is Morocco safe for tourists?

Yes, northern Morocco is generally very safe for tourists. Our routes avoid any problematic areas, and travelling in a group with a local guide adds an extra layer of security. All accommodations have secure parking for motorbikes.
- ▼ What is the weather like during the tour season?

From October to June, temperatures are pleasant for riding, typically 15-25°C (59-77°F). Rain is rare but possible in the winter months. We avoid summer tours due to excessive heat in some regions. We will provide a detailed weather forecast before departure.
- ▼ What about meals and dietary requirements?

Breakfasts are included in all accommodations. For other meals, our guide will recommend authentic local restaurants. Special dietary requirements can be accommodated with prior notice. Moroccan cuisine offers many options for all preferences.
